On 26 June 2014 the Queensland Government approved a range of changes to fees and allowances, including those of the Queensland Civil and Administrative Tribunal (QCAT).

From 1 July 2014, the fee to lodge an application or referral under the *Manufactured Homes (Residential Parks) Act 2003* and the *Retirement Villages Act 1999*, section 157, 167, 169(2), 170(2) or 171(2) changes to \$295.

As part of QCAT's commitment to accessibility, our existing fee waiver program will continue in 2014-15.
